Everyone wants to live an INCREDIBLE life

Three lies we tell ourselves:

I lead a fairly MORAL life

Remind the people to be subject to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready to do whatever is good, to slander no one, to be peaceable and considerate, and always to be gentle toward everyone.
- Titus 3:1-2 (NIV)

At the core, I am a DECENT person

At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and pleasures.

God knows my HEART

We lived in malice and envy, being hated and hating one another.
- Titus 3:3 (NIV)

It is impossible for an IMMORAL, INDECENT

SICK-HEARTED person to have an incredible life

But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy.
- Titus 3:4-5 (NIV)

God does not save INCREDIBLE people,

He saves UNDESERVING people, incredibly

Ingredients of the incredible life:

POWER for the present life

He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior.

PROMISE of eternal life

So that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.
- Titus 3:7 (NIV)

The key to incredible life is TRUST

This is a trustworthy saying. And I want you to stress these things, so that those who have trusted in God may be careful to devote themselves to doing what is good.
